Following on from the well-received D-Day 75 Garden Party and display of 1944 military and civilian events in the Village Hall on the 22nd June, the feedback from those attending that day has been that it would be good to have the chance to spend more time viewing again and in greater detail.

Therefore, by popular request, we plan to set up the display for a repeat viewing.

We intend to run the event over two days, the Bank Holiday weekend of 24th and 25th August. The Village Hall will be open between 2pm and 5pm on both the Saturday and the Sunday.

Entrance will be by ticket that will give unlimited entry for the two days. £2 for adults and £1 for children, on the door. In addition, we will offer a simple cream tea at £3 for a cup of tea/coffee with two scones, cream and jam. The bar will serve Prosecco and Cava at £3 per glass.

We look forward to welcoming everyone to view the extensive collection of information about not only D-Day but also the Battle of Kohima and the Italian Campaign. There are also snippets of information about life in 1944 including fashion, sports, hobbies and life in Wartime. As before the cinema will be showing a footage from 1944 and the music of the 1940s will be playing.

We look forward to seeing you over the Bank Holiday weekend in St. Tudy, at the Village Hall to take tea in the garden and browse the extensive collection of research.
